Business Crime Reduction



:: Business Crime Reduction Partnership

BID Director's Ben Hewson and Rachel Noel sit on the Business Crime Reduction Partnership to help raise awareness and discuss the challenges faced throughout the town and further afield.

As part of this initiative we fully support the use of DISC, a tool used by many businesses throughout the town centre to log and report anti-social and low level criminal activity. DISC should not be used to report serious crime. However, if your business is affected by criminal activity from anti social behaviour to shoplifting, logging an incident report on DISC helps the police use the data and statistics to focus their activities and also help to gather evidence about those committing crime. There is also an option to upload images and names of offenders.

We actively support and encourage you to join if you are not yet a part of it. Please make sure you use it and encourage your staff to do the same. Whilst currently provided by Horsham District Council for free for the first three years, it is our intention as the BID to pick up the cost of DISC going forward, we need your support to make it work and have an impact on our town centre crime rates.
